LETTER FROM PASTOR BRENT

It only took a few months into the pandemic before many of us realized that this was going to last a while, that it wasn't going to be easy, and that it had the potential to bring a lot of change to our lives and to the world as we knew it. After the denial, delusion, and fragile hope that we would breeze through this global pandemic quickly and easily had gone, many of us who follow Jesus sensed that there was more going on with all of this than simply a difficult time to get through. The testimony I have heard from so many people—and certainly the experience I have had over these past two years—is that through it all, God has been and is at work.

CS Lewis once said, “God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks in our conscience, but shouts in our pains: it is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world.”

For me, the past year has been a time of noticing what God is saying and doing more than ever before. Although there generally is more mystery than answers when it comes to the things of God, I can say I have noticed a few things about Him over these past months, both as an individual and as a pastor.

First, I have a new appreciation for God's ability to provide for and take care of His people through every season, even the wilderness seasons. I have seen the goodness, favour, grace and power of God on display in ways I have never seen before in my life. Even in this difficult time of health crisis, political division, lockdowns, war, and economic instability, I have seen the goodness of the Lord, and He truly has brought rivers into the wastelands. As a church, a ministry, and a community, we should marvel at how God has carried us, provided for us, empowered us, blessed us and used us over the past year. Despite all the challenges, we have

seen fruitfulness in most measurable areas. We've seen hundreds profess faith for the first time; we've added so many incredible people and families into our community, and we've been able to continue to drive core health and growth into all of our congregations throughout Atlantic Canada. We've started the process of the official launch of our St. Stephen congregation. We've seen God raise up some incredible new pastoral, ministry and lay leaders. We've seen our Celebrate Recovery ministry, Alpha program, Kings Youth, KC Kids, and our adult discipleship ministries continue to make a HUGE impact all over the Atlantic Canada region and beyond. We've been able to begin the rollout of the Kings Academy of ministry, and, by God's grace, have been able to partner up with the Buckingham Leaders Network, through which God is going to do great things in the years to come. We've also seen incredible growth in tithes and offerings. We've been able to move our Halifax congregation into a new

home, have undertaken renovations in West Saint John, and have given more money away to partner ministries, charities and people in need than we ever have in the 40-year history of our church. God is so faithful.

Second, I have learned that there is purpose in our pain and that God never wastes a wilderness. Beyond all of the metrics that we can measure and celebrate, the most precious thing to me from the past year is the deep work of refinement and transformation God has been and is doing in me, in Kings Church, and, I believe, in the global church. It says in the book of Hebrews, chapter twelve:

“My son, do not take lightly the discipline of the Lord, and do not lose heart when He rebukes you. For the Lord disciplines the one He loves, and He chastises every son He receives.”

The past two years, for me, have been more transformative on a soul, calling, character, and heart level than any before. I am thankful for the challenges, hardships and hurts of this past season, and I've only just begun to get perspective on some of the ways God has used it. He has been shaping me, humbling me, and causing me to dig my roots down deeper. Deeper into His Truth, His love, His grace, His calling on my life, His presence with me, and His goodness to me. I believe this is what The Lord has been doing to His people through all of this. He's been deepening our love, our character, our faith, our commitment. He has been weeding out the weeds, burning up the chaff, moulding us more into the bride we are meant to be. I can't yet put my finger on all of the ways, but I know for certain that I am different than I was two years ago. And, along the same lines, I know that Kings Church has changed in some profoundly deep ways. I believe we will look back years from now and see just how profound the shifts and shaping truly was. I am thankful for the growing awareness of the hand of God causing "all things" (even hard things...no...especially hard things) "to come together for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purposes."

Finally, I have learned that there is an invitation in our afflictions. I've discovered that God longs for us to notice His closeness, and to become truly aware of His character in these wildernesses we journey through in life. This has happened for me, and I know this has been happening for hundreds of my brothers and sisters in Kings Church, and millions of brothers and sisters around the world.

Early in 2020, I was given a verse as a prophetic word over this season. Taken out of Song of Songs, chapter 8:

"Who is that coming out of the wilderness leaning on her beloved?"

I love this picture of the bride of Christ, leaving the woods. Not only leaning on her beloved (the groom) in a way that denotes reliance, but I envision her leaning on Him in such a way that He is not only her strength, but He is her sole focus, the object of her attention and affection. She is so taken by Him that it no longer matters where they are or how they got there; just that she's with Him.

I am amazed at how this picture has become a reality in my life and in the life of our church. I do feel we are coming out of the wilderness, being led by the Bridegroom Himself. But, the longer this season has gone, the more my attention has been drawn to Him. I don't know what's next, I don't know what the future holds, but I know who holds the future. He's holding me, He's holding us, and He's holding His Church. May we continue to lean into Him, learn from Him, and love Him in increasing measure in the days to come.

I continue to count it a supreme blessing of the Father to have been called to serve the King at Kings Church. Thank you, Kings Church, for being the absolute best church I could have ever hoped to pastor. Thank you for loving Melanie, me, Ava, Aden and Alex, along with all of the other Pastoral team so very well. And, above all, thank you for leaning into Jesus.

Let's keep going, leaning on Him, shall we?



TESTIMONIES OF THE HAND OF GOD

"I called my sister late one night because I hit the lowest point in my life. I lost, what I thought at the time, was everything. I was ready to end my life. I was an atheist with a grudge against the world. That night around midnight my sister strong armed me

and told me

that I needed Jesus. Since

I had nothing left I decided to take her offer and go to CR the following day. The second I stood up when Pastor Seth began to sing my whole body was filled with warmth, I felt the Holy Spirit for the first time in my life. Instead of rejecting the Holy Spirit, I let Him fill my heart. In that moment I knew that even though I couldn't physically see God, I could feel how real and how loving He is. Easter weekend 2022 I was baptized at Kings West and God has since radically changed my life. My BPD is silenced, my anxiety is almost non existent, and for the first time in my life I feel whole. God has shown me the purest form of love and has shown me that I'm accepted. He's given me the confidence to speak to others, get on stage and talk in front of a crowd, to share in a group setting, and how to love myself and others. I don't just exist anymore, God has given me new life." "A family in our church community

suffered a tragic loss, and to see not only the West campus, but also the Valley, come together to surround this family was beautiful. My friend and I helped plan a meal train, and the Kings family showed up. It meant the world to the family, and we as a church got to be the hands and feet of Jesus."

"My aunt had to go for a second MRI and if the results were the same as the first one she had she would have needed brain surgery. I asked the prayer team to cover her in prayer and the results came back normal! Wow, God!"

"I'm proud to say that through Jesus healing, I have been able to get off my medication for mental health."

"I requested prayer for my mom who was admitted to hospital for a dye test to check for blockages. Her oxygen levels and blood pressure were both very low and we prayed for her to get strong enough for the test. After having an echo for her heart it was determined she didn't even need the dye test! Things turned around within a week, she went home and is doing remarkably well!"

"Being a part of this family has helped bring me from a lifetime of hurt and fear and rejection, into a place of restoration. And God gets the glory."

"I can finally look at myself in the mirror and see a woman I recognize as a child of God."
