1. Purpose: Grace and peace for the listener/reader by way of revelation/revealing hidden realities, present & future.

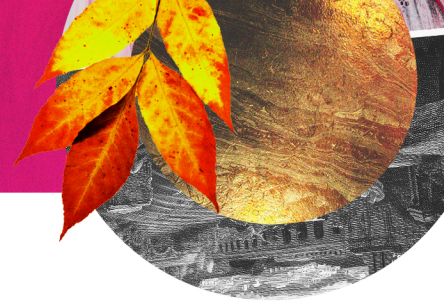
2. Interpretation/Structure: Apocalyptic communication form to be interpreted literarily AND ultimately, now AND future.

3. Big Idea: The Lamb (Jesus) is on the throne ruling in power, truth and grace, and is actively establishing His kingdom.

Application: The Lamb (Jesus) is calling all people to Himself for life and salvation (from judgement) THROUGH His witnesses

And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit. I did this so you would trust not in human wisdom but in the power of God...For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of talk, but of POWER.” (1 Corinthians 2:1-5, 4:20, NLT)

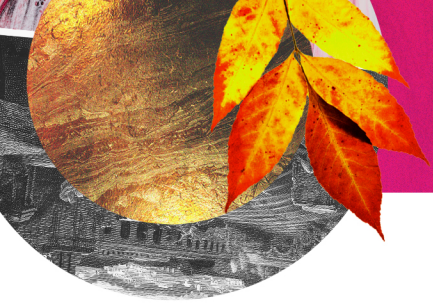

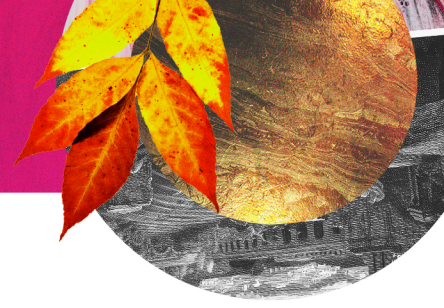
